keeps for protection. Both
are Glocks. He kept them
in our bedroom closet,
hidden and unloaded. They
have been there for years.

I thought about
my son, Troy when I saw
the piece on t.v. and

told my husband we were going that day to get a safe. We went to Bass Pro Shops near us in Clarksville, Indiana and got ~~is~~ a safe.

Meanwhile, our son who is 13 has been having mental health issues because of bullying at school and low self-esteem.

He told his counselor yesterday that he had a bad day on Friday and wanted to end his life. These are the worst words to ever hear in your life. But when he went to find his Dad's gun - he saw a safe instead. Thank the Lord, the guns were in that safe.

Troy is now going into a treatment program at Clark Memorial. He is doing much better and getting lots of help.

I don't know if Troy would have used the gun or not - but if he did, I would have lost him forever and died right along beside him.

Your ad made me realize that all guns in homes need to be kept away from teens and all ages of kids.

I wish I could leave you my contact information, but I told my husband I would not. This is a family matter.

But, I prayed about it
and wanted to tell you that
together we saved Troy's
Life.
